The walk starts at the United Churches, 110 11th Ave SE

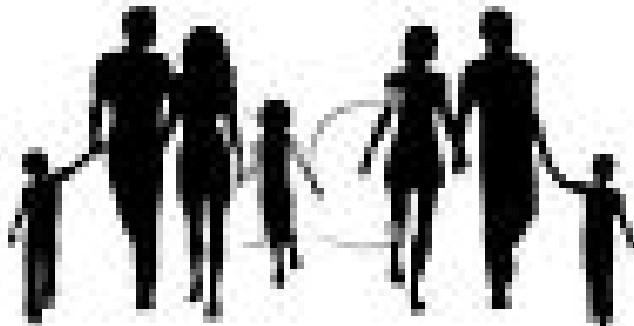
Enter from Washington Street.

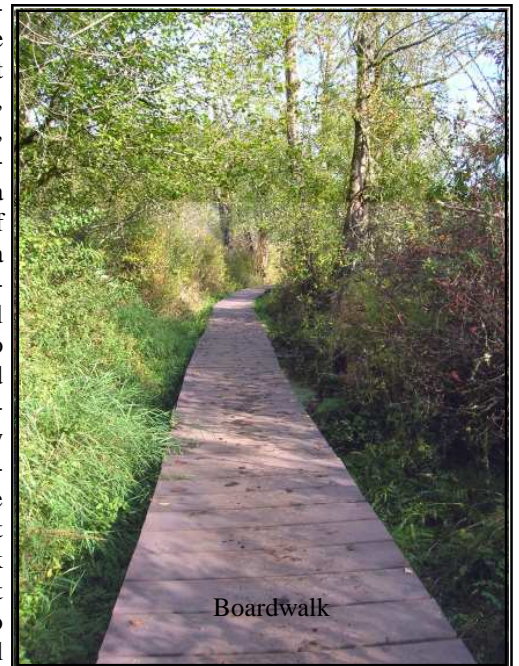
Perki, Sheila, and I want to thank the 25 volunteers, who helped make our event such a success. Bob, Peter, and Cindy
