

**CVC Board Meeting

Members present included President Karen Younkings, Vice Presidents Larry and Cheryl Bush, Treasurer Pam Greig-Davis, Secretary Mary Clem, Sheila Morrison, Membership chair, David Black, ESVA Representative, and Barb Malone.

Topics discussed:

- 1. It was suggested to keep scheduling Tuesday PM walks during the season (April-Sept,) as they are some of the only walks available to those members who are still working. They will continue to be offered the 1st and 3rd Tuesdays of the month, and we will seek volunteers to lead the walks.**
- 2. The decision to reopen the CVC logo store was tabled for now, with the topic to be re-visited with the general membership at a later date.**
- 3. A wide-ranging discussion was had with respect to changing the general meeting schedule. It was suggested that we have a 6 month trial of bi-monthly meetings to start this November, and follow with meetings in January, March, May, and July of 2026. It was decided to elicit a vote of the membership during the November meeting for the proposed schedule. This schedule change would then necessitate a change in club bylaws to have the election for new Club Officers in May instead of June, with a corresponding change in bylaws to form a designated nominating committee for the new Officer candidates in March, rather than April. No changes in bylaws would be necessary simply to change the meeting schedule. Information about the proposed schedule change will be emailed to the membership, as well as placed into the next CVC newsletter.**
- 4. It was decided to ask Bonnie Tucker if she wishes to continue the Garfield Elementary project that we donate to each Holiday season, and to request additional volunteers if she would prefer not to organize it this year.**
- 5. The President agreed to go ahead and reserve the picnic shelter at Squaxin Park for our August, 2026 picnic.**
